

Comprehensive Communication Guide: Sharing Your Request Effectively

Objective

This guide provides best practices, message templates, and key resources for sharing your Switchboard request with your network.

As a worker or organization on Switchboard, you already have access to a network of Kingdom Consultants (KCs) who are ready to assist. However, your personal support network—those who already know and believe in your ministry—is one of your greatest assets for finding the right help.

Tailoring Your Message for Your Audience

Different audiences require different tones and approaches. Personal supporters may appreciate a conversational tone, while churches may need a more formal introduction. Keep messages clear, inviting, and action-oriented.

Key Tip: Make sure your recipient will know what you want them to do after they've read your message.

Follow-Up Strategies

Not everyone will respond right away—follow-ups matter!

- **If no response:** Send a brief follow-up message in about a week.
- **If interested but hesitant:** Offer more details or schedule a short call.
- **If they decline:** Thank them and ask them to share with others who might be interested.
- **If they commit:** Follow up with next steps and keep them engaged.

Message Refinement Checklist

Use the checklist below to make sure your message is compelling, actionable, and aligned with your ministry goals.

Before sending, ask yourself:

- Is the need clear and easy to understand?
- Does it show how the recipient can help?
- Is there a specific next step (e.g., sign up, share the opportunity, schedule a call)?
- Does it maintain consistency with your ministry's unique voice?

Message Templates

Use these templates as a starting point, adjusting as needed for your audience and communication style.

1. Individuals (Friends, Family, Supporters) - Email or Personal Message
