# Switchboard Quick Start Guide

## **Objective**

This guide walks you through the essentials to start using Switchboard immediately. If you've already identified a need in your ministry, follow these steps to connect with skilled virtual volunteers and expand your impact.

## Step 1: Set Up Your Switchboard Account

- 1. Go to globalswitchboard.io/gco-signup and create an account.
- 2. Fill out your profile with a brief description of your ministry and location. (Follow security best practices.)
- 3. Upload a profile picture (optional but helps build trust).

## Step 2: Find Help For Your First Need

- 1. Browse the volunteer skills catalog and find the category of the help you need.
- 2. Select the skills required (e.g., administration, graphic design, translation).
- 3. Describe your need or the issue you need help addressing.
- 4. Submit your request and Switchboard will handle the rest, matching you to a volunteer.

## Step 3: Engage With Interested Volunteers

- 1. Check your Switchboard dashboard for responses. (You'll also receive an email notification each time someone connects with you.)
- 2. Respond promptly and schedule a one-hour introductory call if needed.
- 3. Confirm a clear next step (trial period, task assignment, or follow-up).

Now that you've gotten started, maximize the impact of Switchboard by taking two additional steps:

## Step 4: Share Your Request With Your Network

- 1. Identify key contacts who may know potential volunteers.
- 2. Share your Switchboard request link with your ministry network. (Click here a guide to accessing and sharing your link.)

## Step 5: Build and Maintain Your Virtual Team

- 1. Onboard volunteers with clear expectations and communication guidelines.
- 2. Keep them engaged by providing updates and feedback.

As new needs arise, repeat the process to expand your team.
