# Find Help for Your First Need

- Browse the volunteer skills catalog and find the category of the help you need.
- Select the skills required (e.g. graphic design, translation).
- Describe your need or the issue you want help addressing.
- Submit your request and Switchboard will handle the rest, matching you to a volunteer.



# **Engage With Interested Volunteers**

- Check your Switchboard dashboard or watch for email notifications for responses.
- Respond promptly and schedule a one-hour call if needed.
- Confirm a clear next step (trial period, task assignment, or follow-up).

## Share Your Request With Your Network

- Identify key contacts who may know potential volunteers.

## Build and Maintain Your Virtual Team

- Onboard volunteers with clear expectations and communication guidelines.
- Keep them engaged by providing updates and feedback.
